....In reality, "an elephant never forgets" is a generalization that's not true all the time because all elephants forget things from time to time. However, scientists have proven that elephants do have incredible memories



# 4 steps to consider when walking the elephant out of the room

- 1. Consider the nature & timing of who you are confronting
  - Is it situational?
- 2. Go to the offender first
  - Gossip fixes nothing
- 3. Take someone with you
- 4. Confront, how you would want to be confronted Golden rule of confrontation
