Long Term Care Top Cited Deficiencies 2022

1. Free of Accident Hazards/Supervision/Devices
2. Infection Prevention and Control
3. ADL Care for Dependent Residents
4. Treatment Services to Prevent/Heal Pressure Ulcers
5. Quality of Care
6. Bowel/Bladder Incontinence, Catheter, UTI
7. Food Procurement, Store/Prepare/Sanitary
8. Label/Store Drugs, Biologicals
9. Pharmacy Services/Procedures/Pharmacist/Records
10. Free from abuse and neglect

SMHRF/Developmental Disabilities Top Cited Deficiencies 2022

SMRF

1. Health/Nursing Service
2. Recovery and Rehabilitation Supports Centers
3. Required Policies and Procedures
4. Individualized Treatment Plan
5. Incidents, Accidents, and Emergency Care

Developmental Disabilities

1. Governing Body exercises policy/budget/direction over facility
2. Coordination/Monitoring of Active Treatment
3. Client Protection/residents rights
4. Measurable Care and Progress criteria

Assisted Living Top Cited Deficiencies 2022



1. Resident Rights
2. Service Plans
3. Personnel, Requirements, Qualifications and Training
4. Abuse, Neglect and Financial Exploitations
5. Medications
6. Infection Control (Emergency Rule)
7. Residency Requirements
8. Alzheimer's and Dementia programs
9. Resident Records
10. Food Service

Regulation and Enforcement

TIMELINE

SURVEY EXIT DATE OPENS AN ENFORCMENT CYCLE

State issues the SOD to Facility within 10 business days

30-45 DAYS OPPORTUNITY TO CORRECT if only Level 2 deficiencies (45 days) or a G tag that the facility does not have a history of G or higher back to and including the last annual survey and the tag is not in a SQC category (30 days).

As a courtesy, the State provides a 70 DAY notice of mandatory DOPNA

3 MONTHS is mandatory Denial of Payment for New Admissions

6 MONTHS mandatory Termination of Medicare and Medicaid Certification

Enforcement Process

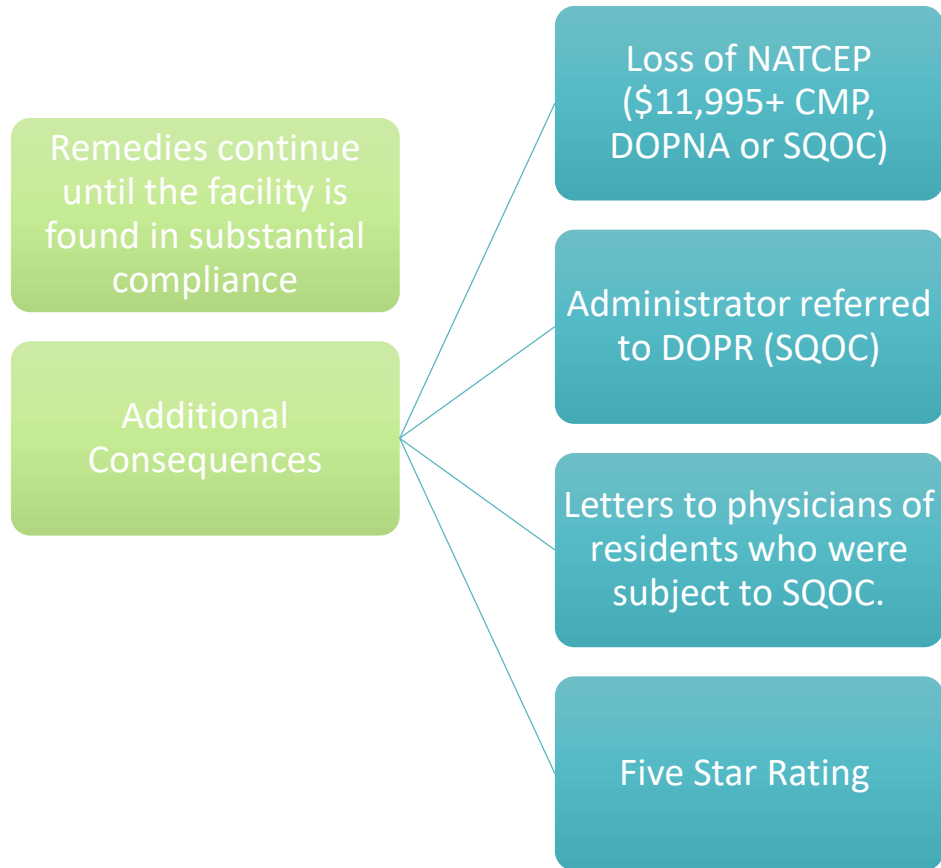
“D” or above begins

Termination in 6
months

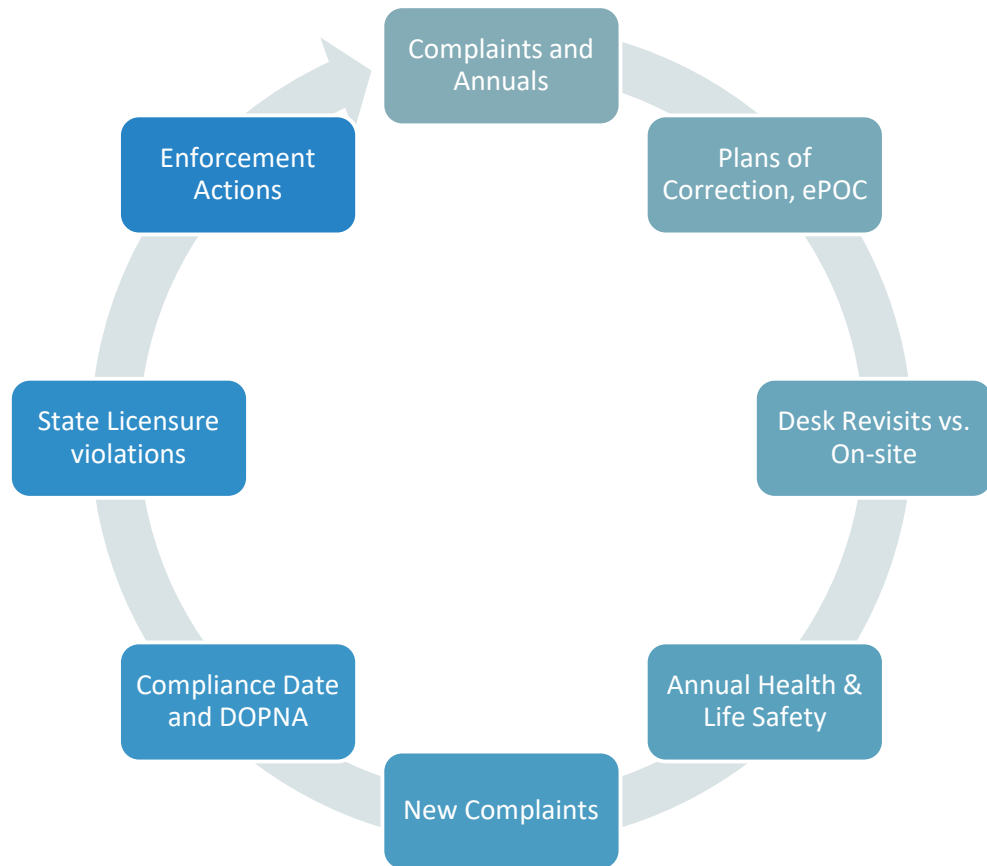
Other remedies may be

must still submit POC
or correct- but are
considered in
substantial compliance.
